Short description: Adoption of measures on electricity efficiency in the Saxon "Action Plan Climate and Energy"



Background:

In the frame of EI-EFF Region different measures on rising electricity efficiency were deducted. These measures have been collected within a list of measures. In order to secure the implementation of the listed measures they need to be part of an official action plan. In Saxony energy efficiency is one major cross sartorial part of the Saxon "Action Plan Climate and Energy". The development and implementation of the action plan is done beside others by the Saxon Ministry of Environment and Agriculture, the Saxon Ministry for Economy and Employment, the Saxon State Ministry for Internal Affairs and the Saxon Energy Agency.

Aim & programme:

New tasks and measures of the Saxon "Action Plan Climate and Energy" had to be defined, adopting the results and measures of the project EL-EFF Region. Thus from November of 2007 up to the first quarter of 2009 several different events had to be held. SAENA participated in three events (ten participants each).

Due the conference "Saxon Action Plan Climate and Energy" in the basic and advanced training site of Reinhardtsgrimma (3rd and 4th September 2007) the measures of the action plan have been discussed. The Workshop "climate protection" in the basic and advanced training site of Reinhardtsgrimma (4th and 5th of September 2008) discussed the implementation of the 300 measures formulated in the "Action Plan Climate and Energy". In the Workshop "Quantitative goals of the climate and energy policy" in Dresden (11th November 2008) quantitative goals of the climate and energy policy in Saxony have been developed. Furthermore several working meetings took place. Three working groups (each average six members) had been launched: energy efficiency, reduction of CO₂ and renewable energies.

Results, follow-up:

As a result of the process 6 measures of the list of measures have been adopted to the Saxon "Action Plan Climate and Energy" and the annual work program of SAENA. These measures address electricity efficient lightning in households, awareness campaign on energy saving, electricity efficiency in low income households, generation of benchmarks in households by lottery, generation of success criteria for energy saving households, electricity efficient lightning in municipalities and environment friendly procurement.
