Title: Conference “Energy efficiency and renewable energy sources in the development of the region”

Short description:

The event was organized by BAPE with the support of SAPE (Association of Energy Agencies in Poland) and Energy Conservation Foundation in Gdańsk and it was held under the honorary patronage of Marshal of Pomeranian Region.

The conference was addressed to representatives of local and regional authorities, architects, planners, district heating companies, real property managers and developers, construction and engineering companies, energy auditors and advisers, home owner associations and housing cooperatives. The event focused on sustainable energy development of Pomeranian Region, the role of spatial planning and development and financial mechanisms supporting the investment projects in energy efficiency and renewable energy sources available within the frame of Regional Operational Programme. The other topics were the tools facilitating sustainable energy development in a community, a present status of building certification system and the role of Energy Regulatory Office in the implementation of National Energy Efficiency Action Plan.

Background:

The share of renewable energy in Poland should rise to 15% in 2020 and the energy consumption should drop by 9% to 2016. The measures are defined in Directive 2006/32/EC on energy end-use efficiency and energy services and the measures implemented to achieve the target established by the directive aim will be carried out with the financial support of programmes funded by European Union. Therefore it is crucial to educate the decision-making institutions and energy consumers in these obligations imposed on Poland and inform them about available tools to fulfil them.

Aim & programme:

The aim of the conference was to present current activities related to the implementation of Energy Efficiency Directive and to the increased use of renewable energy in Pomeranian Region.

The conference was a great opportunity to launch “Minus 10%” Campaign and present it to larger audience. Mrs Katarzyna Grecka from BAPE presented the aims of the campaign and the project as well as the materials developed under the project and encouraged the participants to promote the action in their organizations and environment and to undertake to save electricity in their own households and workplaces.
